ORDER

As per the Government order read above, Liquidated Damages are exempted and Clause 7.13 of Chapter VII of AICTE Approval Process Hand book 2019-2020 is incorporated in KEAM prospectus. Accordingly, if a student leaves after joining the course and the vacated seat is not filled , institution should refund the security deposit and return the original documents to the student. The tuition fee is not mentioned in the refund cases for the unfilled seats. As per the said order, the tuition fee will not be refunded to the students who apply for the release certificate after the last allotment date.

In case, the student after joining the course attended the Spot Admission and subsequently allotted to another course on the last date of admission, he/she may not receive TC on the fag end of the last date of allotment. Hence, Kerala State Human Rights Commission issued proceedings on petitions received from those who attended the spot admission on the last allotment date and received the allotment and were unable to apply for TC on the same day. As per the Proceedings, Kerala State Human Rights Commission opined that the students who are allotted new Colleges in spot admission and applied for TC on the very next day shall be considered for refund of tuition fees along with the the security deposit and return the original documents to the student.

Government examined the matter in the light of the opinion of the Commission and are pleased to order to refund all the fees including tuition fees to the students those who are attending the spot admission on the last allotment date and allotted to a new College. The students should apply for the transfer certificate

on the very next working day of allotment. It is also ordered that the above condition will be applicable to all the Colleges who participate in the Spot admission. The commissioner for Entrance Examinations should make necessary modifications regarding this in the KEAM Prospectus.

Government order read above stands modified to the above extent.
